



Request for Waiver of TSSAA PPE Requirement for 2020-2021

The COVID-19 pandemic has caused the significant disruption of non-emergency services provided by health care providers in many communities across the state. As a result, there may be a scenario where students experience significant delays when attempting to schedule a pre-participation physical examination (PPE) that meets the requirements outlined in the TSSAA Bylaws.

In the event a student is unable to secure the services of a health care provider prior to the first practice date, schools may accept this form in lieu of a pre-participation physical evaluation (PPE) form, provided the student had a PPE for last school year dated on or after April 15, 2019. Students that did not have a PPE last school year may not participate in practice until a PPE dated on or after April 15, 2020 is completed.
